#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 8.6% since 2017, growing by 157,908. Population is expected to increase by 8.0% between 2022 and 2027, adding 160,224.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 8.5% in 12 Georgia Counties from 806,123 to 874,818. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.4% by 5.1%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.6% to 64.5% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, 23.4% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (2.6% above the national average), and 8.4% hold an Associate's Degree (0.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Services to Buildings and Dwellings.




#### Mar 2023 Labor Force Breakdown









## **Unemployment by Ethnicity**







### **Job Trends**








#### Millennials












### **Top Growing Industries**






#### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**








### **Top Industry GRP**



## **Educational Pipeline**


