- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 24.1% since 2017, growing by 16,285. Population is expected to increase by 20.8% between 2022 and 2027, adding 17,490.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 55.0% in Jackson County, GA from 27,677 to 42,889. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.4% by 51.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 69.1% to 71.1% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.9% of Jackson County, GA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.9% below the national average), and **8.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Warehousing and Storage, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Lessors of Real Estate.




Mar 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



Educational Attainment






Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends








Millennials

Jackson County, GA has 16,324 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 16,400.




Veterans

Jackson County, GA has 4,116 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 4.217.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Jackson County, GA. The national average for an area this size is 23,864 people 55 or older, while there are 21,253 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Jackson County, GA. The national average for an area this size is 32,671 racially diverse people, while there are 17,238 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration










