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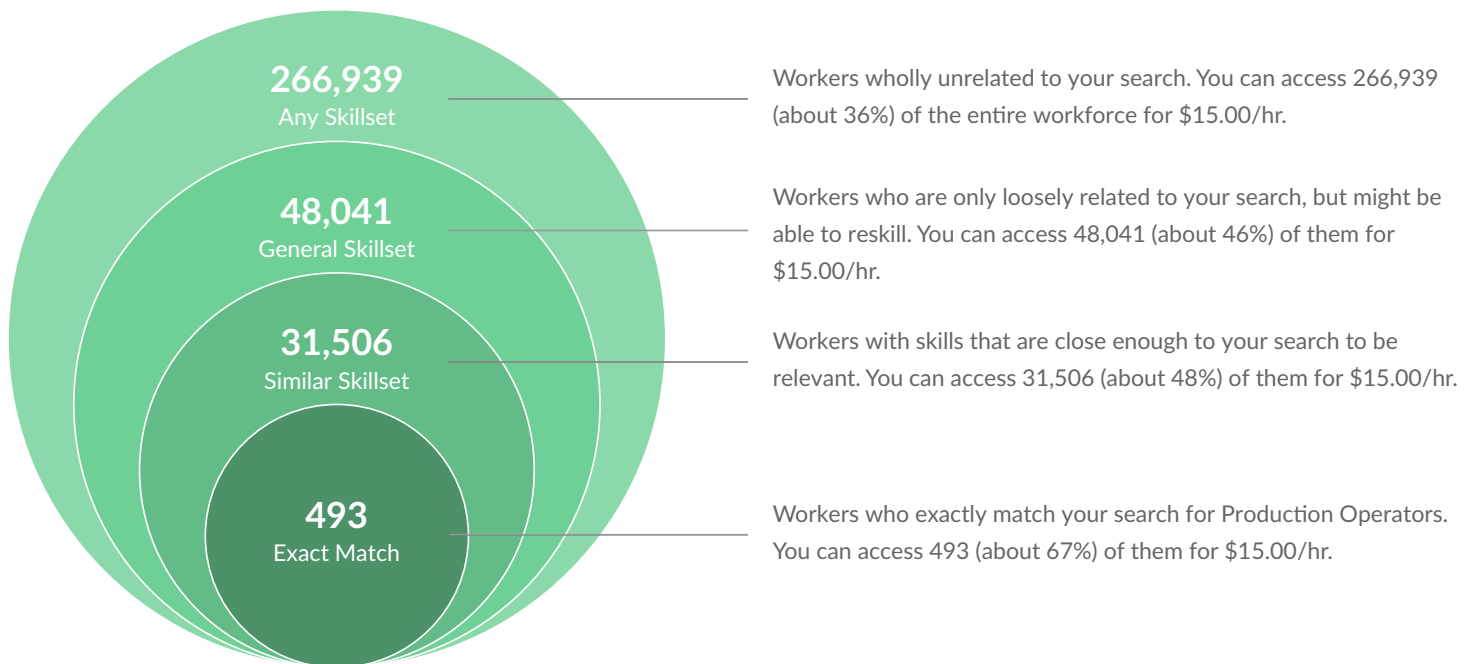

Executive Summary

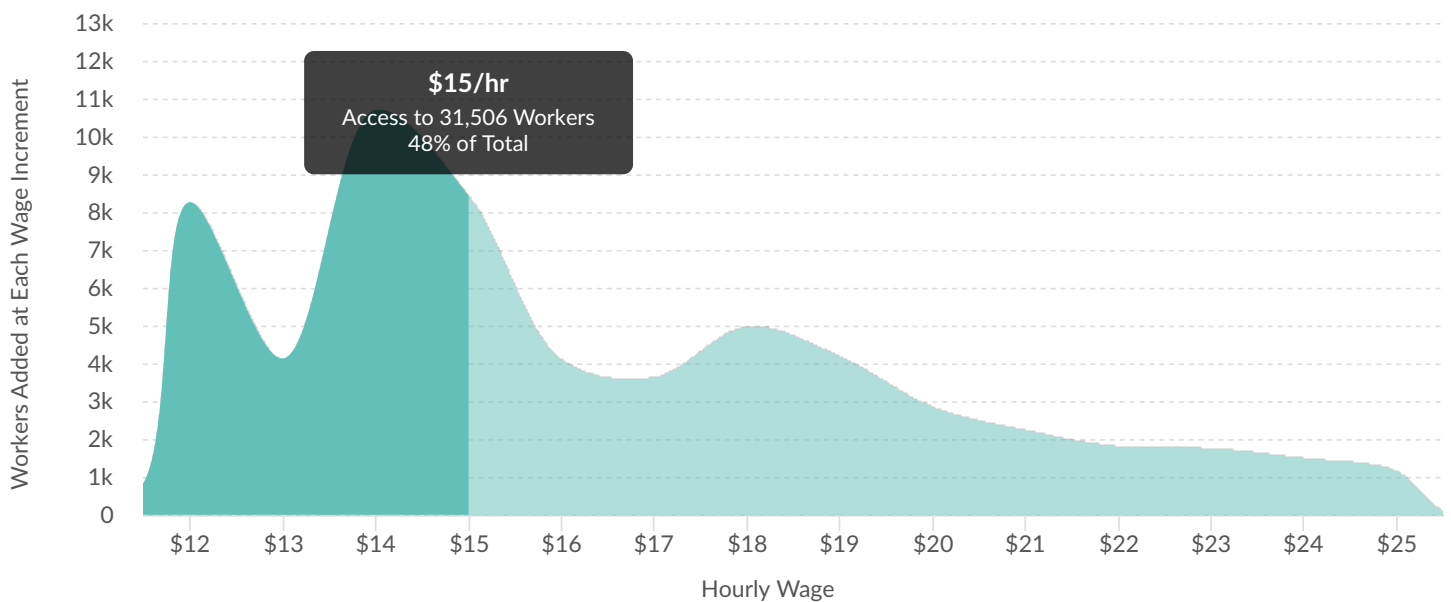
Workforce availability @ \$15.00/hr ranges from 493 to 266,939 depending on skills match.
