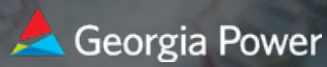

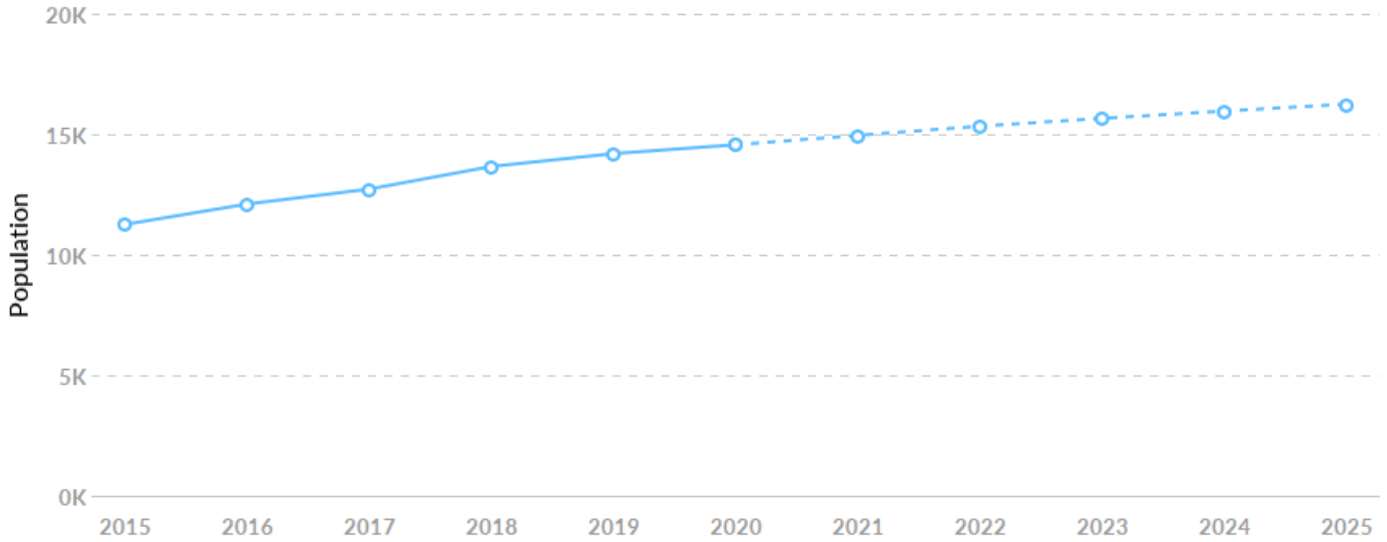

## Population Trends

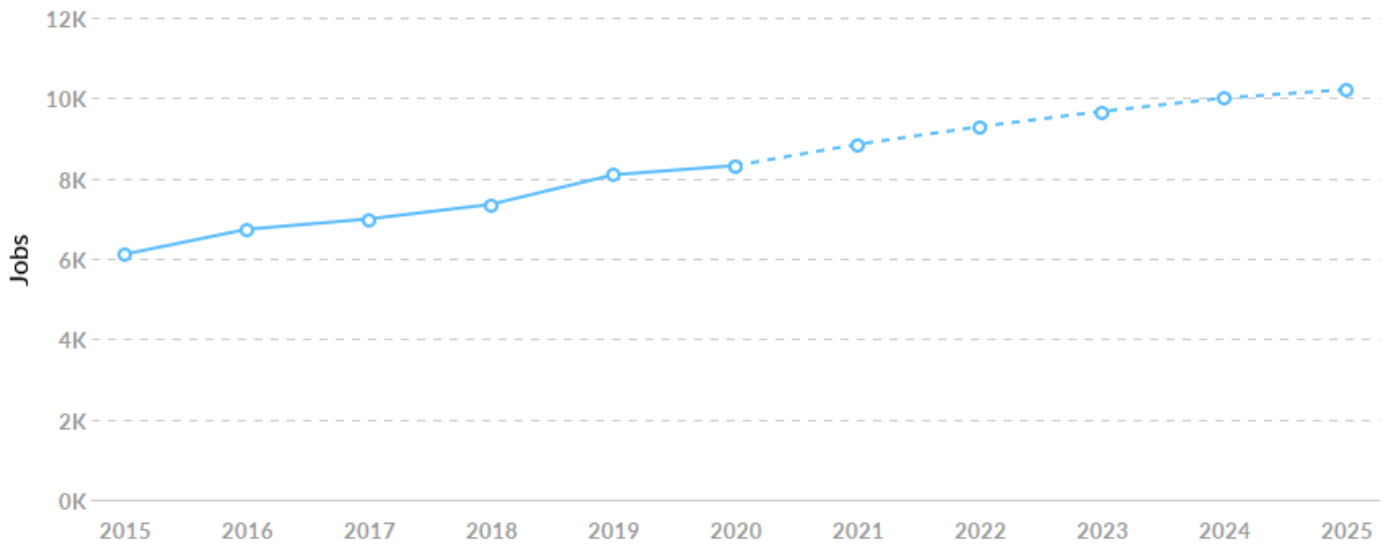

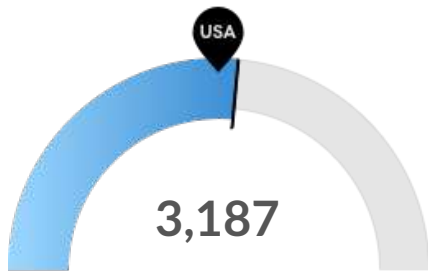
## Job Trends

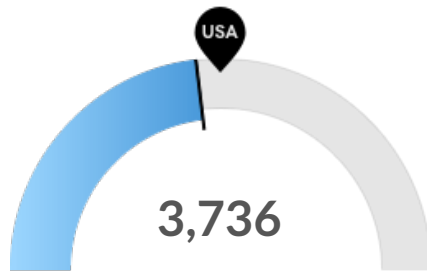

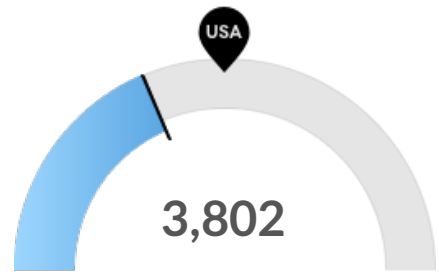
**Millennials**

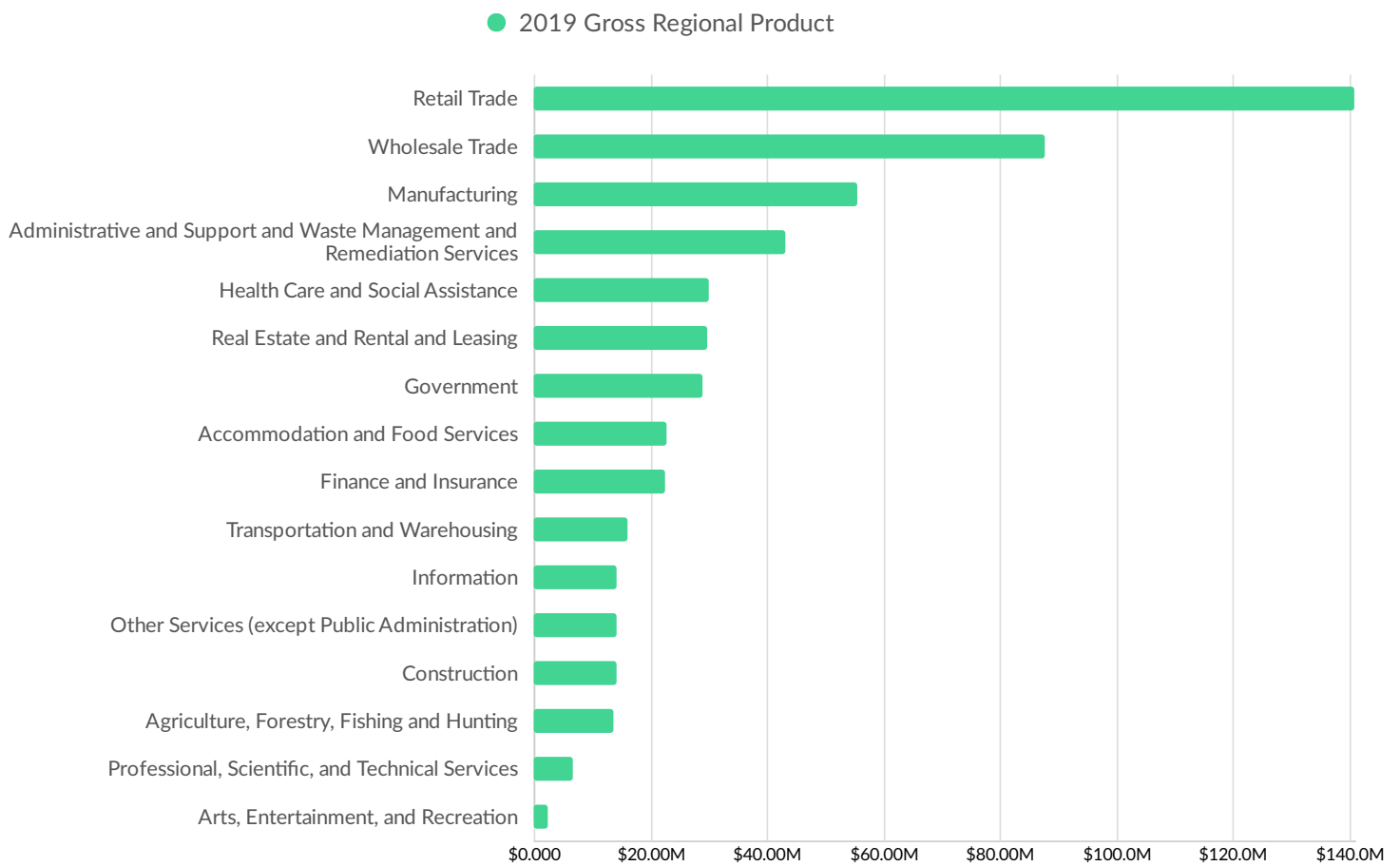

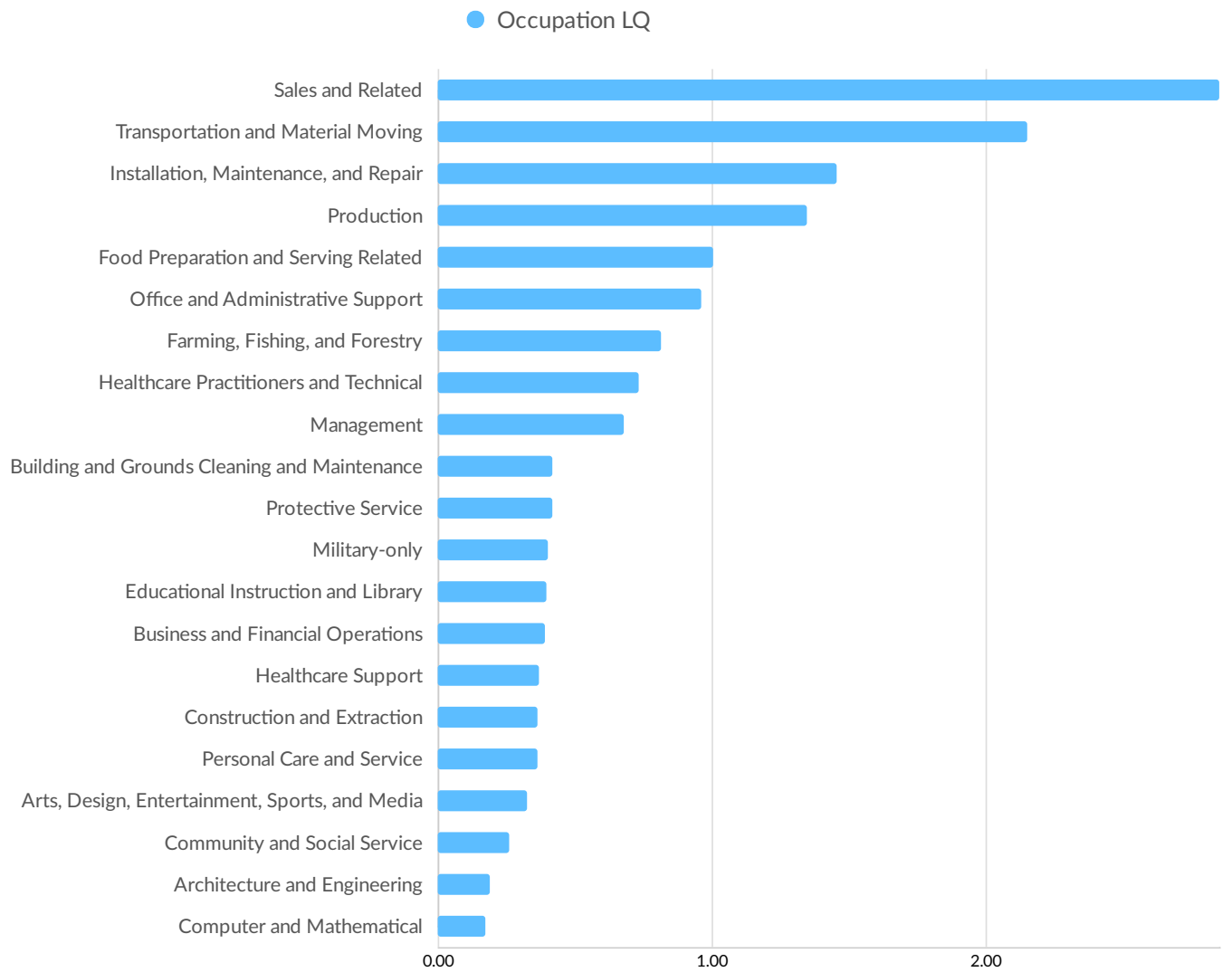

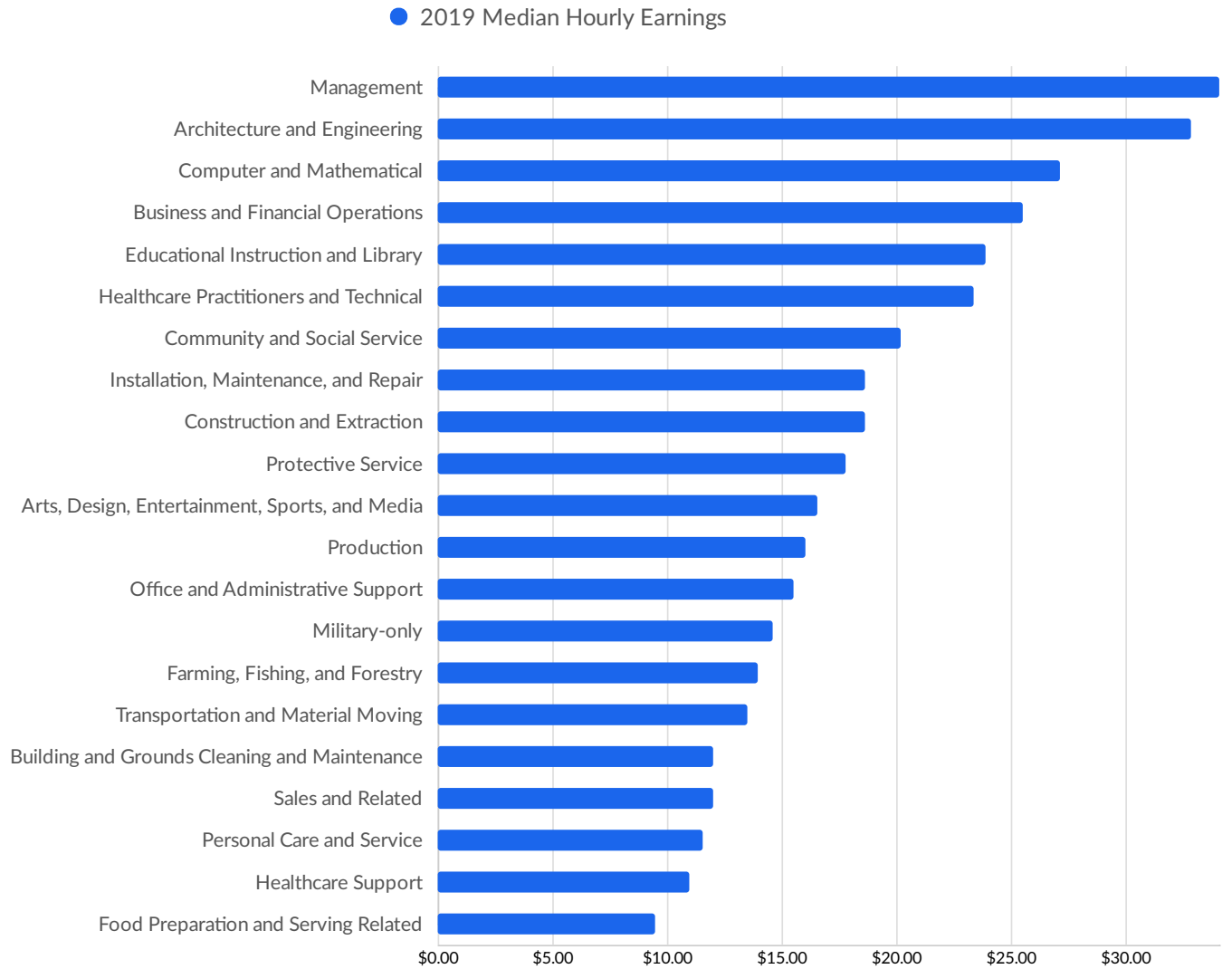

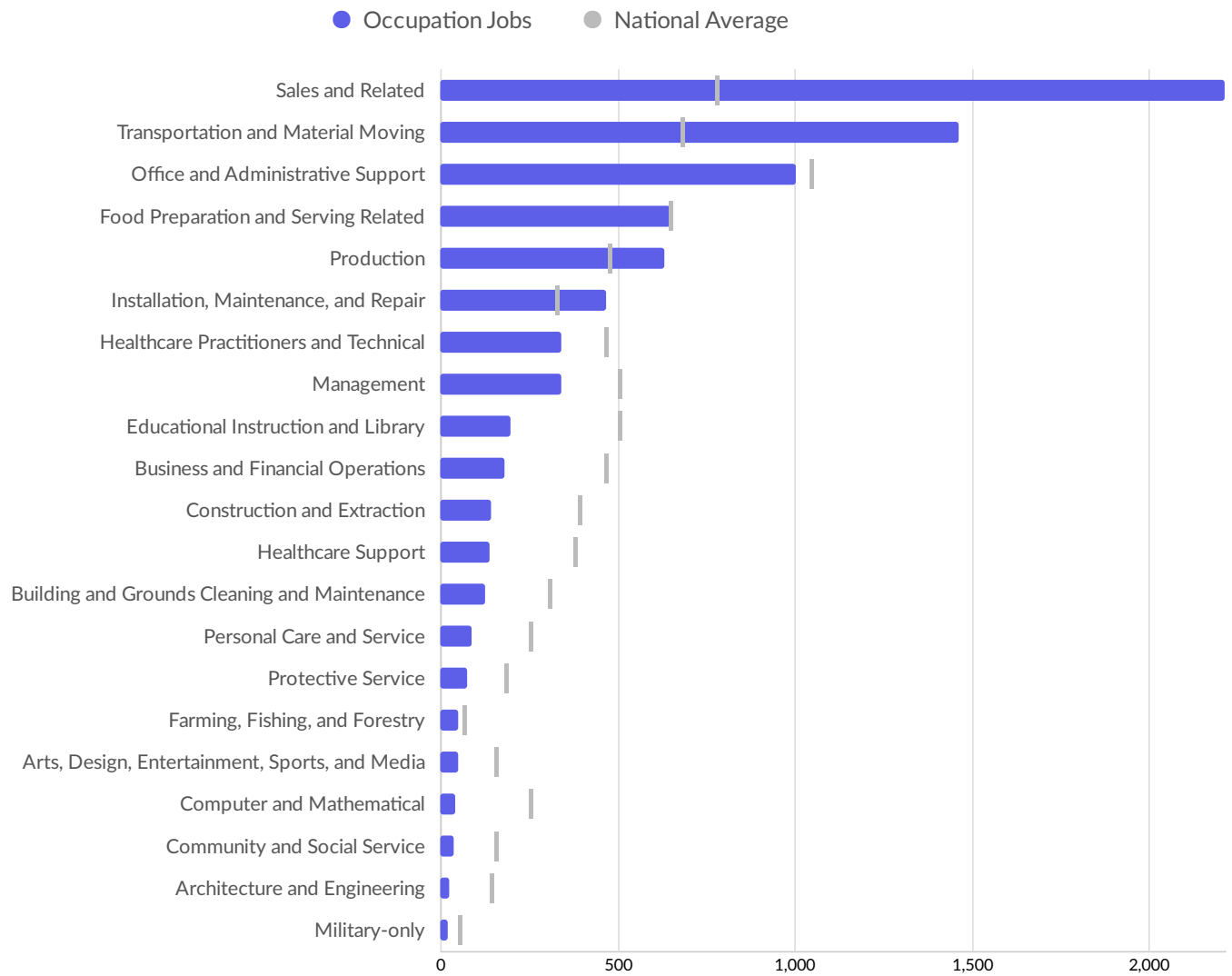
